



The proposed effective date is July 25, 2014. Water passing through the meter prior to that date will be billed at \$2.01 per 1,000 gallons. Water passing through the meter on and after that date will be billed at \$2.91 per 1,000 gallons. At an increase of \$.90 per 1,000 gallons this would be a monthly increase of \$14,650.80 based on an average monthly usage of 16,278,667 gallons.

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by FPB. However, the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged that differ from the proposed rate contained in this notice.

Any corporation, association, or person with a substantial interest in the matter may, by written request, within thirty (30) days after publication or mailing of this notice of the proposed rate change, request to intervene. Intervention may be granted beyond the thirty (30) day period for good cause shown.

If the Commission does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of mailing of this notice, the Commission may take final action on the proposed rate.

Requests for intervention should include the status and interest of the party, establish grounds to intervene, and should be sent to the Public Service Commission, P.O. Box 615, Frankfort, KY 40602.
