
Dear Ms. Ramser:

Thank you for sending me for review and comment the memorandum concerning the January 21, 2015, Informal Conference held in the above-referenced case. My comments to the memorandum are as follows:

- 1) Please add the following sentence to the end of the fifth paragraph of the memorandum: "PSC suggested that Bullitt Utilities consider filing a petition requesting authorization to treat the costs incurred to address the failure of the Hunters Hollow Treatment Plant as a regulatory asset."
- 2) Please revise the first sentence of the eighth paragraph of the memorandum to state: "Mr. Moore indicated that the owners of Bullitt Utilities may transfer ownership of Bullitt Utilities to another entity, possibly Bullit County Sanitation District, at the end of 2016."
