Pursuant to the Commission's Order issued September 26, 2014, an informal conference was held in this matter on October 30, 2014. Attached is a copy of the attendance roster.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the current status of the application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity

George Wakim questioned the necessity of a new building. Lindsey Ingram, counsel for Kentucky-American Water Company, stated that any temporary fixes would not solve the long term problems. After investigating all possibilities, Kentucky-American Water Company came to the conclusion that a new building is the least cost alternative.

The front part of the building and the clearwell are the oldest parts of the building. Additions were built throughout the years with the last addition occurring in the 1950s. The building has been completely depreciated.

Although awards have been received, Kentucky-American Water Company has concerns about the continued viability of the current building. Supports for the upper level have been added throughout the building.

Mr. Wakim expressed an interest in a site visit. Ann Ramser and Mr. Ingram agreed to schedule a site visit to occur within the next two weeks.

There being no further business, the informal conference adjourned.
