Filing deficiencies pursuant to:

807 KAR 5:001 Section 4(3):

Name, address, telephone number, fax number and e-mail address of submitting party or attorney (no email address).

807 KAR 5:069:

If applicable, a statement that notice meeting the requirements of Section 3 of this administrative regulation has been given, together with a copy of the notice – Notice does not meet requirements in 807 KAR 5:069 Section 3(4).

807 KAR 5:069 Section 2(4):

A copy of the preliminary and final engineering reports and bid tabulations (preliminary not available).

807 KAR 5:069 Section 2(a)(1):

If the construction project involves facilities to treat or distribute water, a statement that the proposed plans and specifications for the project have been designed to meet the minimum construction and operating requirements set out in 807 KAR 5:066, Section 4(3) and (4), Section 5(1), Sections 6 and 7, Section 8(1) through (3), Section 9(1) and Section 10.

807 KAR 5:069 Section 2(b):

That all other state approvals or permits have been obtained.

807 KAR 5:069 Section 2(c):

That the proposed rates if any, shall produce the total revenue requirements recommended in the engineering reports.

807 KAR 5:069 Section 2(d):

Dates upon which construction will begin and end.

807 KAR 5:069 Section 2(8):

If applicable, a motion requesting approval to deviate from a minimum construction standard or operating condition required by subsection (6)(a) of this section, together with supporting evidence to identify and explain the reasons that the minimum requirements cannot be met.

The statutory time period in which the Commission must process this case will not commence until the above-mentioned information is filed with the Commission. If your filing contains a proposed effective date, the rejection of your filing for reasons of deficiencies voids that proposed effective date. When you file the required information to correct the deficiencies, you may re-file your proposed tariff with a new proposed effective date that is a least 30 days from the date you file the required information. You are requested to file 10 copies of this information within 15 days of date of this letter. If you need further assistance, please contact my staff at 502-564-3940.
