RE: Informal Conference of February 10, 2025

Pursuant to a Staff Notice issued on February 3, 2025, an informal conference (IC) was conducted on February 10, 2025. Attached is a copy of the attendance roster.

The purpose of the IC was to discuss Cannonsburg Water District's (Cannonsburg District) water loss surcharge monitoring and reporting process, including actions that increased the effectiveness of the water loss reduction activities. Cannonsburg District discussed the unaccounted-for water loss reduction efforts it has undertaken to date, including zone metering and dedicating one employee to water loss detection efforts on a daily basis. Cannonsburg District stated that the zone metering has been instrumental in helping to locate problem areas and assist in reducing unaccounted-for water loss.

Cannonsburg District also provided an update regarding its plan to replace water lines in the Shopes Creek area and the status of that project. Cannonsburg District explained that the majority of the funding for the Shopes Creek Project will be coming from grants. Cannonsburg District confirmed the Shopes Creek project has been bid, and once all funding and regulatory approvals have been received, Cannonsburg District plans to ask the Commission for approval to use all remaining water loss surcharge funds towards the project. Cannonsburg District stated it is in the process of filing an application with the Commission for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for the Shopes Creek project.

There being no further discussion, the IC was then adjourned.
