On October 2, 2014, the Commission Staff and parties held an informal conference to discuss substantive and procedural issues of the above-referenced case. A memorandum memorializing the informal conference was entered into the record of the case on October 7, 2014. This letter is being submitted for the purposes of clarifying the record as stated in the informal conference memorandum. Please file this letter in the record of the case.

The memorandum states that I "requested that the issue be submitted to the Commission without a hearing." Although I raised the issue of whether this matter could be submitted to the Commission without an evidentiary hearing, this discussion was contained in the broader context of possible courses of action. No formal request for submission was made at the informal conference, as there would necessarily need to be a stipulation of facts (or other evidentiary foundation for the Commission's ruling) and written legal briefs.

If Water Service Corporation of Kentucky decides to request the matter be submitted to the Commission without an evidentiary hearing, it will file a written motion with the Commission.
