ORDER

On August 8, 2014, Western Rockcastle Water Association ("Western Rockcastle") filed an application to revise its meter-connection fee for a 5/8- by 3/4-inch meter for the provision of water service. Western Rockcastle has advised the Commission of its intention to place the proposed revisions in effect on September 1, 2014. KRS 278.180(1) states that no change shall be made by any utility in any rate except upon 30 days' notice to the Commission. Based on the filing date of August 8, 2014, the earliest these rates could become effective is September 7, 2014.

Having reviewed the proposed revisions, we find that further proceedings are necessary to determine their reasonableness, that these proceedings cannot be completed prior to the effective date of the proposed revisions, and that the proposed revisions should be suspended pursuant to KRS 278.190(2).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:


1. This proceeding is established to investigate the reasonableness of the proposed revisions.
2. Western Rockcastle shall notify its customers of the revisions in accordance with 807 KAR 5:011, Section 8.

3. Western Rockcastle's proposed revisions are suspended for five months, from September 7, 2014, up to and including February 6, 2015.

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by the Association but the PSC may order rates to be charged that differ from the proposed rates contained in this notice.

Any person may submit a timely written request for intervention by mail to the Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 615, Frankfort, KY 40602. The request for intervention must establish the grounds for the request including the status and interest of the party.

If the PSC does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of the initial publication or mailing of notice, the PSC may take final action on the tariff filing.


