Mr. Derouen,

I am Terry Coker, operator of record for Evergreen Sewage Disposal System in Franklin County, KY. The facility permit number is KY 0078298. I am a contractor and not an employee of Evergreen SDS. I have again been requested by Michael Dailey, President of Evergreen SDS to contact you concerning the request to deviate from the 7 day equipment check for the Evergreen Sewage Disposal System Wastewater Treatment Plant.

It was brought to my attention a couple of weeks ago that I had not responded to an email sent in August that was requesting more data. I had not responded to the email because the subject line read "Do Not Reply" and the first line stated that our deviation request had been logged in as case # 2014-00290. I read no further thinking this was just notification that you had received the request letter and a response would be mailed, as usual, to us at a later date.

After going back and reading the entire email, I realized that a request for more data was included in the email. After reading the request, I concluded that it was going to take many hours of research to answer and verify all of the data that was requested. I have neither the time for such research nor does Evergreen SDS have the funds.

The Evergreen SDS has only 40 residences that it serves and at this time 6 of those are vacant, leaving 34 paying residents. With limited financial income for Evergreen SDS, it is a financial strain for Evergreen SDS to continue to pay for research and documents to pursue this deviation request that may not be approved after all is said and done. The money is better spent checking the plant equipment seven days per week and making repairs. This extra checking of the equipment will make it necessary for Evergreen SDS to request a rate increase in the near future.

Therefore, I request that my previous request for a deviation from the 7 day per week checking of the equipment be removed from your consideration.

As of November 1, 2014 we will be checking all of the equipment which consists of one (1) blower and two (2) pumps seven (7) days per week.
