Kentucky Power Company notifies the Public Service Commission of Kentucky of its election to employ the Commission-prescribed electronic filing procedures in all Kentucky Power Demand-Side Management cases filed after August 18, 2014, and the Company requests a deviation from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8(2) to the extent they require that an individual written notice of its election to use electronic filing procedures be filed prior to the Company's filing of each future demand-side management application. In support of its election and request, Kentucky Power states:

- 1. Kentucky Power currently uses electronic filing procedures in connection with its six-month and two-year environmental surcharge and fuel adjustment clause reviews. The Company has determined that the electronic filing procedures promote the through and efficient review of such proceedings.
- 2. On July 28, 2014 Kentucky Power filed its "Notice of Election Filing Procedures" in connection with the Company's Demand-Side Management application scheduled to be filed on or before August 15, 2014.
- 3. Kentucky Power anticipates its Demand-Side Management applications and proceedings will be of a similar size and complexity as its fuel adjustment clause and environmental surcharge review proceedings, and thus are likely also to benefit from the

employment of the Commission's electronic filing procedures.

- 4. 897 KAR 5:001, Section 8(2) facially provides that applicants are required to file their written notice of election to use electronic filing procedures on the Commission-prescribed form in connection with each application. Although the burden of doing so is not significant, it nevertheless will be more efficient for both the Commission and the Company if Kentucky Power files a single notice of election to use such procedures in all future Demand-Side Management cases.
- 5. Filed with this notice and motion is the Commission-prescribed form setting forth the Company's "Notice of Election Filing Procedures" in connection with all future Demand-Side Management applications filed on or after August 18, 2014.
- 6. This notice of election to use electronic filing procedures is applicable only to the Company's future Demand-Side Management applications and proceedings.

Wherefore, Kentucky Power Company respectfully requests:

- 1. The Commission accept its notice of election to employ the Commission-prescribed electronic filing procedures in all Kentucky Power Demand-Side Management applications and proceedings filed after August 18, 2014;
- 2. The Commission grant a deviation from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8(2) to the extent they require that an applicant file an individual written notice of its election to use electronic filing procedures prior to the applicant's filing of each demand-side management application; and
 - 3. Granting the Company all other relief to which it may be entitled.
