1. That Applicant is a water district created and existing under and by virtue of Chapter 74 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes.

That Applicant, pursuant to the provisions of KRS 278.023, seeks (i) a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, permitting Applicant to construct the Water System Improvements Project Phase X (the "Project"); (ii) an Order approving increased water rates; and (iii) approval of the proposed plan of financing said Project.

4. That the Project consists of the construction, installation and/or replacement of (i) certain undersized lines and asbestos cement lines along Headquarters Road; and (ii) waterlines along a portion of Crooked Creek Road. The Project also includes the refinancing of certain short term debt incurred to fund the Phase IX project (see PSC Case No. 2009-00126).

5. That Applicant proposes to finance the construction of the Project through (i) the issuance of \$555,000 of its Waterworks Revenue Bonds; (ii) a USDA, Rural Development ("RD") grant in the amount of \$200,000; and (iii) a Tobacco Settlement grant in the amount of \$185,000. Applicant has a commitment from RD to purchase said \$555,000 of bonds maturing over a 40-year

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
