

### NOTICE

Due to a rate increase from the City of Jackson, KY, notice is hereby given that Breathitt County Water District has filed an application for a Purchased Water Adjustment with the Kentucky Public Service Commission for the purpose of adjusting its water rates. Customer rates will increase by \$0.66 per 1,000 gallons used. The proposed change will be effective for service rendered on and after November 1, 2014.

The monthly bill for a customer using an average of 5,000 gallons per month will increase \$3.30 from \$55.85 to \$59.15 or 6%.

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by Breathitt County Water District. However, the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged that differ from these proposed rates. Such action may result in rates for consumers other than the rates in this notice.

Breathitt County Water District has available for inspection at its office the application submitted to the Public Service Commission. The office is located at 1137 Main Street, Suite 305, Jackson, KY 41339.

Whereas, the Breathitt County Water District Board did pass and approve a proposed rate increase for the Breathitt County Water District Systems at the October 6, 2014 Emergency Water Board Meeting.

Whereas, motion was made and approved by a vote of 3-2 that the Breathitt Water District Board increase the minimum bill from \$22.34 to \$23.66 and an increase per thousand after the first two thousand gallon from \$11.17 per thousand to \$11.83 per thousand to become effective for billing cycle due November 1, 2014.

**Whereas**, cause for the proposed rate increase was impending the rate increase of purchased water from the City of Jackson.

NOW THERFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Breathitt County Water Board that the proposed rate increase for the Water System will become effective for billing cycle due November 1, 2014.
