PETITION FOR CONFIDENTIALITY

The City of Danville, by counsel, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13, respectfully request the Public Service Commission to grant confidential protection to certain information provided by the City in response to the Commission Staff's supplemental information requests in this proceeding. The information for which confidential protection is sought is the entire participant manual from an AWWA seminar.

Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13(2) sets forth a procedure by which certain information filed with the Commission shall be treated as confidential. Specifically, the party seeking confidential treatment must establish "specific grounds pursuant to KRS 61.878 for classification of that material as confidential." 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13(2)(a)(1). Paragraph (c) of KRS 61.878(1) protects information that is confidential or proprietary; paragraphs (k) and (l) protects information the disclosure of which is prohibited by federal or state laws. The participant manual indicates that it has been copyrighted by AWWA. As such, it should be granted confidential treatment for a permanent period of time.
