On this date, Tuesday, February 24, 2015, the Attorney General is filing his (1st) Supplemental Data Requests in the above-styled matter. These data requests include certain items for which the petitioner, Kentucky Power Co. ["KPCo"], has sought confidential protection. As you may be aware, the Attorney General entered into a confidentiality agreement with KPCo in which the Attorney General, among other things, agreed to protect the confidentiality of information which KPCo deems confidential, and for which it seeks confidential protection from the Public Service Commission. KPCo has filed with the Commission a petition for confidential treatment, dated February 11, 2015. To date, it appears that the Commission has yet to rule on this petition.

In accordance with Commission procedures, the Attorney General has separately printed each page containing any information for which Big Rivers has sought confidential protection, and is placing these pages in a sealed envelope marked "Confidential."
