PURCHASED WATER ADJUSTMENT FILING OF NICHOLAS COUNTY WATER DISTRICT CASE NO. 2015-00276

### ORDER

On September 8, 2015, Nicholas County Water District ("Nicholas County") filed an application for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure.<sup>1</sup>

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, finds that:

- Nicholas County purchases water from the city of Carlisle ("Carlisle"),
   Buffalo Trail Water Association ("Buffalo Trail"), Western Fleming County Water District
   ("Western Fleming"), and the Kentucky American Water Company ("Kentucky American").
- 2. On October 27, 2014, Western Fleming increased its wholesale water rate to Nicholas County from \$1.43 per 1,000 gallons to \$1.63 per 1,000 gallons.<sup>2</sup> Nicholas County proposed to increase its water rates to reflect the increased cost of purchased water effective September 1, 2015.

- 3. During the 12 months ended May 31, 2015, Nicholas County purchased 130,431,176 gallons of water, 92,301,900 of which were purchased from Western Fleming, and sold 95,189,380 gallons of water. The increase in the cost of purchased water is \$18,460.38, resulting in a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.20 per 1,000 gallons.
- 4. In its application, Nicholas County incorrectly calculated the increased cost in purchased water and the resulting purchased water adjustment factor.
- 5. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.20 per 1,000 gallons, as calculated in Appendix A to this Order, is fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.
- 6. The rates as set forth in Appendix B to this Order, are fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved for water service rendered on and after September 1, 2015.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.20 per 1,000 gallons is approved.
  - 2. Nicholas County's proposed rates are denied.
- The rates set forth in Appendix B to this Order are approved for services rendered by Nicholas County on and after September 1, 2015.
- 4. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Nicholas County shall file with the Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revised tariff sheets showing the rates approved herein.
