ORDER

On September 3, 2015, East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. ("EKPC") moved the Commission for an extension of time, until September 30, 2015, in which to file its testimony and responses to the request for information in the Commission's August 31, 2015 Order. In support, EKPC states that the additional time is necessary because this proceeding covers 18 months, rather than the six months of traditional reviews, and in order to accommodate prescheduled employee vacations and existing obligations and to provide additional time for EKPC's member cooperatives to determine whether to seek rehearing in the previous environmental surcharge review, Case No. 2014-00051.¹

The Commission, having considered EKPC's motion, finds that good cause exists to grant the motion. The Commission further finds that the procedural schedule in Appendix A to the August 31, 2015 Order should be amended to accommodate the two-week time extension.

- 1. EKPC's motion is granted.
- 2. EKPC is granted an extension of time to file its testimony and responses to the August 31, 2015 information requests up to and including September 30, 2015.
- The procedural schedule set forth in the Appendix to this Order shall be followed.
- 4. All provisions of the Commission's August 31, 2015 Order not in conflict with this Order shall remain in full force and effect.
