ORDER

On October 14, 2015, BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Kentucky (“AT&T Kentucky”) filed a motion requesting leave to withdraw its response filed on October 12, 2015, and replace it with an amended response, which was tendered with its motion. In the alternative, AT&T Kentucky moves for leave to replace the October 12, 2015 response with a redacted response, also tendered with its motion.


As grounds for its motion, AT&T Kentucky states that it mistakenly filed an earlier version of its response that contained potentially commercially sensitive information concerning interconnections between AT&T Kentucky and three competitive local exchange carriers (“CLEC”). The information includes the number of AT&T Kentucky’s wire centers with which the CLECs are interconnected, as well as the number of interconnection trunks the CLECs utilize to interconnect with the wire centers. AT&T Kentucky claims that this information is commercially sensitive, may be considered proprietary, and, to its knowledge, has not otherwise been made publicly available. AT&T Kentucky also states that the response contains textual errors that the amended response corrects, but the redacted version does not.

Having reviewed the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that AT&T Kentucky has established good cause to permit it to withdraw its response and replace it with the amended response.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. AT&T Kentucky's motion to withdraw its October 12, 2015 response is granted.
2. AT&T Kentucky's request to replace the October 12, 2015 response with the amended response is granted.
3. The original October 12, 2015 response shall be removed from the official record of this case.
