ORDER

Kentucky Rural Water Association ("KRWA") has applied for accreditation and approval of its Northeast Regional Meeting held on October 13, 2015, in Morehead, Kentucky; Green River Regional Meeting held on October 15, 2015, in Owensboro, Kentucky; and its Western Regional Meeting held on October 22, 2015, in Draffenville, Kentucky. These meetings provide useful information to attendees to help them better perform their role as a utility professional and to enhance operations at their facilities.

On November 16, 2015, the Commission received a letter from Janet Cole, Education Coordinator for KRWA, in which Ms. Cole attested that these programs were held as scheduled, and that the planned course of instruction was performed as submitted. Ms. Cole also submitted a list of Commissioners who attended the meetings and earned education credit for the course. Finally, Ms. Cole submitted a copy of the approval by the Kentucky Board of Certification of Water Treatment and Distribution System Operations.

This Commission is required to "encourage and promote the offering of high quality water district management training programs that enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties." Having

reviewed KRWA's application, the Commission finds that the presentation at the meetings will enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties and should be accredited for two hours of water district management training.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- The presentation at the Northeast Regional Meeting held on October 13,
 in Morehead, Kentucky, is accredited and approved for a maximum of two credit hours of water district management training.
- The presentation at the Green River Regional Meeting held on October
 2015, in Owensboro, Kentucky, is accredited and approved for a maximum of two credit hours of water district management training.
- The presentation at the Western Regional Meeting held on October 22,
 in Draffenville, Kentucky, is accredited and approved for a maximum of two credit hours of water district management training.
- 4. KRWA shall retain a record of all water district commissioners attending the accredited and approved presentations.
