ORDER

On January 6, 2015, Licking Valley Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Licking Valley RECC") submitted an application and tariff filing seeking approval of a permanent on-bill financing program titled Kentucky Energy Retrofit Rider ("KER Rider"). The proposed KER Rider will allow customers to pay for energy-efficiency retrofits from the savings derived from those retrofits. Along with its application, Licking Valley RECC provided multiple attachments and exhibits, including prepared testimony and a proposed tariff with an effective date of February 5, 2015.


Having reviewed the filing and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that an investigation of the proposed KER Rider tariff is necessary to determine its reasonableness and that such investigation cannot be concluded prior to the proposed effective date. Consequently, the Commission will initiate this proceeding and, pursuant to KRS 278.190(2), will suspend the effective date of the proposed KER Rider tariff for five months, up to and including July 4, 2015.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Licking Valley RECC's proposed KER Rider tariff, designated P.S.C. No. 3, Original Sheet Nos. 1-7, is suspended for five months, up to and including July 4, 2015.
