Pursuant to the Commission Staff's March 6, 2015 notice, an informal conference was held in this matter on March 9, 2015 to discuss the status of and issues in this case. Attending the conference were:

At the start of the conference, Mr. Spenard stated that Commission Staff would prepare minutes of the conference for the case record, that a copy of the minutes would be provided to all parties, and that all parties would be given an opportunity to submit written comments upon those minutes. Mr. Spenard stated that the views of Commission Staff were not binding on the Commissioners, and he provided a procedural history of the case which included the fact that the procedural schedule established by the Commission's February 10, 2015 Order had been suspended.

The parties agreed that electronic procedures should be utilized for this case.

The parties agreed that the procedural schedule contained in the Commission's February 10, 2015 Order needed to be revised and reinstated.

The parties discussed a revised procedural schedule for the case. Mr. Wuetcher stated that the city of Augusta ("Augusta") had provided information to the Bracken County Water District ("Bracken District"), and the parties discussed whether and how the information could be made part of the record of the case. Mr. Wuetcher stated that Bracken District anticipated having more questions for Augusta and wanted to have the

opportunity to submit its initial requests to Augusta on or before March 16, 2015. Mr. Wuetcher stated that Bracken District wanted to reserve the opportunity to file testimony.

Commission Staff, Augusta, and Bracken District discussed the Commission's initial request for information and dates for a revised procedural schedule that would include an initial request by Bracken District, two additional rounds of discovery for Commission Staff and Bracken District, the opportunity for Bracken District to file testimony, a round of discovery for Commission Staff and Augusta upon any testimony that Bracken District filed, an informal conference, and a public hearing.

Mr. Wuetcher stated that there are other issues that Bracken District would like to discuss with Augusta such as rate mechanics, management, and the operation of the plant. He stated that Bracken District would like to engage in settlement discussions with Augusta because he believed that the parties could resolve their issues, and Ms. Thompson indicated that Augusta was open to settlement discussions.

There being no further business, the informal conference adjourned.
