29	4. A copy of this petition with the Confidential Information redacted has	been served
30	on all parties to this proceeding. 807 KAR 5:001 Section 13(2)(b). A copy of the Co	nfidential
31	Information has been served on all parties that have signed a confidentiality agreemer	nt.

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1 5. The Confidential Information is not publicly available, is not disseminated within 2 Big Rivers except to those employees and professionals with a legitimate business need to know 3 and act upon the information, and is not disseminated to others without a legitimate need to know and act upon the information. 4 5 6. If and to the extent the Confidential Information becomes generally available to 6 the public, whether through filings required by other agencies or otherwise, Big Rivers will 7 notify the Commission and have its confidential status removed. 807 KAR 5:001 Section 8 13(10)(b). 9 7. The Confidential Information is entitled to confidential protection based upon 10 KRS 61.878(1)(m)(1), which protects "[p]ublic records the disclosure of which would have a reasonable likelihood of threatening the public safety by exposing a vulnerability in preventing 11 12 protecting against, mitigating, or responding to a terrorist act." 8. 13 The Confidential Information includes critical energy infrastructure information 14 in the form of a detailed map of Big Rivers' transmission system and a one-line diagram showing 15 in detail the components of Big Rivers' transmission system. As disclosure of this information 16 would provide the public with detailed schematics of the Big Rivers transmission system, this 17 information should be granted confidential treatment. 18 9. Big Rivers requests that the Confidential Information remain confidential 19 indefinitely because as long as the transmission system remains in place, the information should 20 be confidential for the reasons stated above. 807 KAR 5:001 Section 13(2)(a)(2). 21 10. Based on the foregoing, the Confidential Information is entitled to confidential 22 protection. If the Commission disagrees that Big Rivers is entitled to confidential protection, due

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1	process requires the Commission to hold an evidentiary hearing. Utility Regulatory Com'n v.
2	Kentucky Water Service Co., Inc., 642 S.W.2d 591 (Ky. App. 1982).
3	WHEREFORE, Big Rivers respectfully requests that the Commission classify and protect
4	as confidential the Confidential Information.
