The snow has melted and crocus and daffodils are coming into bloom. It is time for spring garden chores.

Now is the time to apply crabgrass pre-emergence herbicides.

The goal is to apply before soil temperatures at a 4-inch depth reach 55 degrees.

In western Kentucky it is recommended to apply the pre-emergence herbicides before April 1.

These herbicides need to be applied before seed germination.

However, seed will not all germinate at once a later application will still be beneficial in reducing crabgrass germination.

Peak germination is normally in late May or
