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East Kentucky Network, LLC, d/b/a Appalachian Wireless, was granted authorization to provide Personal Communications Service ("PCS") in the Middlesboro-Harlan, KY Basic Trading Area (BTA295) by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC). FCC license is included as Exhibit 1. East Kentucky Network, LLC merger documents were filed with the Commission on February 2, 2001 in Case # 2001-022. East Kentucky Network, LLC is a Kentucky Limited Liability Company that was organized on June 16, 1998. East Kentucky Network, LLC is in good standing with the state of Kentucky.

In an effort to improve service in Bell County, East Kentucky Network, LLC pursuant to KRS 278.020 Subsection 1 and 807 KAR 5:001 Section 9 is seeking the Commission's approval to construct a 300 foot self-supporting tower on a tract of land located on Church Road, Pineville, Bell County, Kentucky (36°45'45.43"N 83°40'25.89"W). A map and detailed directions to the site can be found in Exhibit 7.

Exhibit 2 is a list of all Property owners or residents according to the property valuation administrator's record who reside or own property within 500 feet of the proposed tower in accordance with the Public Valuation Administrator. No other properties are contiguous with East Kentucky Network's property.

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:063 Section 1 (1)(L) and Section 1(1)(n)(1) all affected property owners <u>according to the property valuation administrator's</u> record who reside or own property within 500 feet of the proposed Tower were notified by certified mail return receipt requested of East Kentucky Network, LLC's proposed construction and informed of their right to intervene. They were given the docket number under which this application is filed. Enclosed in Exhibit 2 is a copy of that notification.

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Bell County has no formal local planning unit. In absence of this unit the Bell County Judge Executive's office was notified by certified mail, return receipt requested of East Kentucky Network Limited Liability Company's proposal and informed of their right to intervene. They were given the docket number under which this application is filed. Enclosed in Exhibit 3 is a copy of that notification.

Notice of the location of the proposed construction was published in the Pineville Sun, June 25, 2015, edition. Enclosed is a copy of that notice in Exhibit 3. The Pineville Sun is the newspaper with the largest circulation in Bell County.

A geologist was employed to determine soil and rock types and to ascertain the distance to solid bedrock. The geotechnical report is enclosed as Exhibit 4.

A copy of the tower design information is enclosed as Exhibit 5. The proposed tower has been designed by engineers at World Tower Company Inc. and will be constructed under their supervision. Their qualifications are evidenced in Exhibit 5 by the seal and signature of the registered professional engineer responsible for this project.

The tower will be erected by S & S Tower Services of St. Albans, West Virginia. S & S Tower Services has vast experience in the erection of communications towers.

FAA and Kentucky Airport Zoning Commission applications are included as Exhibit 6.

No Federal Communications Commission approval is required prior to construction of this facility. Once service is established from this tower we must immediately notify the Federal Communications Commission of its operation. Prior approval is needed only if the proposed

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facility increases the size of the cellular geographic service area. This cell site will not expand the cellular geographic service area.

East Kentucky Network, LLC will finance the subject Construction with earned surplus in its General Fund.

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Two notice signs meeting the requirements prescribed by 807 KAR 5:063, Section 1(2), measuring at least two (2) feet in height and four (4) feet in width and containing all required language in letters of required height, have been posted, one at a visible location on the proposed site and one on the nearest public road. The two signs were posted on April 23, 2015, and will remain posted for at least two weeks after filing of this application as specified.

Enclosed in Exhibit 8 is a copy of East Kentucky Network LLC's Amendment and Restatement of Lease for the site location along with a lot description.

The proposed construction site is on a very rugged mountaintop some feet from the nearest structure. Prior to construction the site was wooded.

East Kentucky Network LLC's operation will not affect the use of nearby land nor its value. No more suitable site exists in the area. A copy of the search area map is enclosed in Exhibit 7. One tower was found within the search area but is not capable of supporting East Kentucky Network, LLC's load and future needs; therefore, there is no opportunity for co-location of our facilities with anyone else.

Enclosed, and filed as Exhibit 9 is a survey of the proposed tower site signed by a Kentucky registered professional engineer.

Exhibit 11 contains a vertical sketch of the tower supplied by James W. Caudill, Kentucky registered professional engineer.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that the PSC accept the foregoing Application for filing, and having met the requirements of KRS [278.020(1), 278.650, and 278.665] and all applicable rules and regulations of the PSC, grant a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct and operate the proposed tower.

Pineville Tower Site

Purpose:

A site assessment was conducted for Appalachian Wireless on a tract of land located in Bell County near Pineville, Kentucky. The site of the proposed tower is now forestland. The purpose of this investigation was to determine the depth to bedrock and of what type of rock the bedrock consists.

Site Investigation:

The trenching method was used to determine the type of bedrock material at the proposed tower site. An excavator was used to expose the bedrock material. It is approximately 3.50 feet to the sandstone bedrock. (See attached page for descriptions of materials encountered.) The terrain in Bell County is moderately to very steep. The tower site is located on a ridge north of the Cumberland River and approximately one mile east of the city of Pineville in Bell County. The sandstone formation below the tower site is approximately 10.00 feet thick based on the information obtained from the site investigation and geological maps of the area.

Conclusions:

The proposed tower site is located on a ridge in the area. The sandstone bedrock on the proposed tower site is part of the Hance Formation of the Breathitt Group, and is middle to lower Pennsylvanian in age. Tests were not conducted to determine the load-bearing strength of the bedrock. However, it is apparent that the tower will be constructed on the sandstone bedrock formation.

The field work for this site was performed by Wendell R. Holmes, using generally accepted methods in the practice of geological science.

AMENDED AND RESTATED LEASE AGREEMENT

THIS AMENDED AND RESTATED LEASE AGREEMENT is made and entered into on this the 5^{4h} day of 3000, 2015, with a commencement date of October 1, 2014, by and between Knuckles Enterprises, Inc., a Kentucky corporation with a mailing address of 119 Kate Corner, Leitchfield, KY 42754, hereinafter referred to as "Lessor" and East Kentucky Network, LLC d/b/a Appalachian Wireless, with a mailing address of 101 Technology Trail, Ivel, Kentucky 41642, hereinafter referred to as "Lessee."

WITNESSETH:

The parties hereto previously entered into that certain Lease Agreement ("Original Lease") dated September 29, 2014, pursuant to which the Lessee leased from Lessor a certain tract of real property located on the waters of Bird Branch, in Bell County, Kentucky. Said Original Lease was evidenced by that certain Memorandum of Lease ("Original Memorandum") dated of even date therewith and of record in Book L52, Page 337 in the Office of the Clerk of Bell County, Kentucky.

The parties hereto desire to amend and restate the Original Lease to amend the original property description and deed of reference, and replace it with the real property description stated herein and evidenced in its entirety on Exhibits A and B attached hereto, and made a part hereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing premises and the representations, warranties, mutual covenants and agreements hereinafter set forth, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Lessor and Lessee agree that the Original Lease is hereby amended and restated so that, as amended and restated, it shall read in its entirety as follows:

1. LEASED PREMISES

Lessor does hereby grant, demise and lease unto Lessee, and Lessee does hereby lease from Lessor, for the terms and conditions set forth in this Lease, the premises located on the waters of Bird Branch, in Bell County, Kentucky, more particularly described below and further identified on Exhibits A and B attached hereto: (hereinafter referred to as the "Premises")

Beginning on a set iron pin with cap marked 1s2259 set on the lower edge of a trail near the top of Pine Mountain, said point being located North 67 deg 01 min 52 sec East, 101.83 feet from a found iron pin with cap on the Northeast corner of Crown Castle's tower site area and then severing the land of Knuckles Enterprises, Inc. (Book 228, Page 523) and thence running around the hill North 57 deg 44 min 34 sec East, 100.22 feet to a set iron pin with cap marked 1s2259 on the lower edge of a trail; thence running down the hill South 32 deg 10 min 56 sec East, 99.99 feet to a set iron pin with cap marked 1s2259 on the hillside; thence running around the hill South 57 deg 44 min 01 sec West, 99.85 feet to asset iron pin with cap marked 1s2259 on the hillside; thence running around the hill South 57 deg 44 min 01 sec West, 99.85 feet to asset iron pin with cap marked 1s2259 on the beginning. Containing a calculated area of 10004 square feet or 0.23 acres and being wholly contained within the Knuckles Enterprises Inc., Property.

Being a portion of the same property conveyed to Lessor from Otis and Rossie Knuckles, Ray and Roxie Knuckles, Millie and Mack Woolum, Ellen and Marvin Porter, Leonard and Joyce Knuckles, Clayborn and Birdie Knuckles, Hazel and Dock Jones, Dorothy and Jim Spears, and Ed Knuckles by Deed dated October 29, 1979, and recorded in Deed Book 228, Page 523, in the Bell County Clerk's Office.

The Lessor grants unto Lessee full and complete right of ingress, egress and regress over roads located upon this property controlled by Lessor to and from the Premises and the non-exclusive right to use any existing road on this property. It is understood that either party has the right to, but not the obligation to perform maintenance on said existing access road. In the event the Lessee desires to relocate all or any portion of an existing roadway or to construct another access road to the Premises, the location of such roadway shall be mutually agreed upon by Lessor and Lessee. Lessor further grants to the Lessee a right of way and easement to construct and maintain and operate telephone and power transmission lines over Lessor's property to the Premises for service of the tower and related facilities, said lines to be located where feasible along the access road to the Premises, with Lessor having input as to location of said power transmission lines in the event Lessee changes the location of its access road. Lessee shall have the right to trim or remove trees, limbs or underbrush, which interferes with its access road or power/telephone lines wherever such road and lines are located.

This lease is made on the following terms and conditions:

2. TERM OF LEASE. The term of this lease shall be for a period of five (5) years from the commencement date of this lease agreement (the "Initial Term"), with an allowance of an additional six (6) automatic renewals of five (5) years each, unless Lessee provides sixty (60) days written notice that it does not wish to renew.

3. CANCELLATION. Lessee shall have the right to terminate this lease and abandon the Premises at any time under its sole discretion, upon six (6) months written notice to Lessor of its intention to do so. In the event that the Premises fail the process for approval as an acceptable cellular tower site by the Federal Communications Commission or any tests or requirements as required for such approval (the "FCC Process") or approval by the Public Service Commission of Kentucky (the "PSC"), then this lease may be terminated by Lessee upon thirty (30) days written notice of such intention. Upon termination of this lease, Lessee shall have one hundred eighty (180)

days thereafter to remove all structures it has erected upon the Premises, and to reclaim the Premises. All lease payments shall continue until all structures are removed.

4. CONSIDERATION. In consideration for the Premises, Lessee shall pay Lessor Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) per month for the first five (5) year term. After the first five (5) year term, the next six (6) renewals will have an increase of five percent (5%) per five (5) year term. If Lessee rents space on this tower to any other carrier, then the Lessor will be paid Ten Percent (10%) of the rent that Lessee collects. This will be in addition to the regular rent paid to the Lessor.

5. USE OF PREMISES. Lessee shall have the exclusive rights and privileges of the use of the Premises for the purpose of constructing buildings, towers and other related facilities, including, but not limited to telephone lines, coaxial lines, power lines and installation of any other equipment deemed necessary by Lessee to receive and transmit electronic signals in the service area to be served by the facility. The parties hereto recognize that technology in the communications field is advancing at a rapid rate and that this site may be used for any other purpose deemed necessary to carry out the objectives of Lessee, that being to transmit and receive signals and communications by wire, fiber optics, radio and satellite. Lessee shall not use the Premises for purposes other than maintenance or as a site for communications by the use of methods now or hereafter known.

6. INDEMNITY. Lessee agrees to indemnify and save harmless the Lessor from any and all liability by virtue of Lessee's activities upon the Premises or in the exercise of any rights and privileges granted herein, specifically including, but not limited to any claim, loss, fine, penalty and costs (including reasonable attorney's fees) arising out of any violation of any environmental laws or regulations. This provision shall survive the termination of the lease. Lessee shall maintain and keep in full force and effect public liability and property damage insurance in an amount of at least One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00). Lessor shall not be held liable for personal injury or property damage on the Premises whether or not associated with Lessee.

7. TAXES. Lessee shall pay all personal property taxes assessed on or any portion of such taxes attributable to the equipment used by Lessee on the Premises. Lessor shall pay when due all real property taxes and all other fines and assessments attributable to the Premises. Lessee shall reimburse the Lessor additional compensation for any increase in real estate taxes levied against Lessor which are attributable to or arise as a result of the improvements constructed by the Lessee, its successors or assigns.

8. NOTICES. All notices, demands, or other writings in this lease provided to be given, made or sent, or which may be given or made or sent, to either party hereto to the other, shall be deemed to have been fully given or made or sent when made in writing and deposited in the United States Mail, certified and postage prepaid as follows:

11. BINDING EFFECT. All of the terms, conditions, and covenants hereof shall be binding and shall inure to the benefit of the heirs, representatives, successors, and assigns of the parties hereto.
