NOTICE

Salyersville Water Works (Salyersville) is providing notice that it is filing with the Public Service Commission on or before May 1st, 2015 to increase its wholesale rate to Magoffin County Water District effective for water service rendered on and after June 10, 2015. The proposed rate is as follows:

Current Rate	Proposed Rate	\$ Difference	% Difference
\$2.65 per 1,000 gallons	\$2.91 per 1,000 gallons	\$0.26 per 1,000 gallons	10% increase

Water flowing through the meter(s) before the effective date will be charged at the current rate while water flowing through the meter(s) on and after the effective date will be charged at the proposed rate.

This filing may be examined at Salyersville's offices located at 401 College Street in Salyersville.

The filing may also be examined at the offices of the Public Service Commission located at 211 Sower Boulevard in Frankfort, Kentucky, Monday-Friday from 8:am - 4:30 pm or on the PSC website at <http://psc.ky.gov>.

The proposed rate is the rate proposed by Salyersville but the Public Service Commission may order a rate that differs from the proposed rate.

Intervention may be requested by submitting a timely written request for intervention by mail to the Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 615 Frankfort, Ky. 40602. The request for intervention must establish the grounds for the request including the status and interest of the party.

If the Public Service Commission does not receive a written request for intervention within (30) days of the providing of this notice, the Public Service Commission may take final action on the filing.

The proposed rate change sought by the Salyersville Water Works shall occur at the same time and shall be in the same percentage of the change as applied to all customers of the Salyersville Water Works, who are located both inside and outside the City of Salyersville, Kentucky.

The proposed rate increase sought by the Salyersville Water Works is to help meet the increased cost of operation and ongoing required maintenance is in no way for increased capitalization of the Salyersville Water Works System.


