Good morning.

On August 4, 2015, the Commission entered an Order requiring that the city of Salyersville file its responses to the requests for information contained in Appendix B to the Commission's May 18, 2015 Order (within seven days of the date of the August 4th Order). (Link below)

The Order was served to the electronic mail addresses on file with the Commission for this case. The Commission has not yet received a response to the August 4, 2015 Order.

As I noted in my June 15, 2015 electronic mail message, Salyersville needs to file its responses to the Commission's request for information. As part of the filing (for compliance with the Commission's August 4, 2015 Order), Salyersville will need to file a motion for an extension of time for the PSC to accept the filing. If Salyersville has reached a settlement with Magoffin County Water District concerning the matter, there is a need for Salyersville to communicate that development to the Commission through a formal filing (that includes the settlement documents).

Although the views of Commission Staff are not binding on the Commission or its Commissioners, there is a concern with the extended delay for the filing of the responses because the delay impairs the ability of the Commission to conduct its investigation into the reasonableness of the proposed rate adjustment within the time limits of KRS 278.190. The Commission may enter an Order dismissing, without prejudice, Salyersville's proposed new rate if the Commission finds that the lack of timely-filed responses prevents the ability of the Commission to determine the reasonableness of the proposed rate.
