RE: Proposed Purchase Water Adjustment

To Whom It May Concern:

The West Shelby Water District respectfully requests that the Public Service Commission allow us to make an adjustment in our rates in accordance with 807 KAR 5:068 Purchased Water Adjustments for Water Districts.

Our supplier, The Louisville Water Company (LWC), has informed the District that an increase will become effective July 1, 2015. The District purchased 236,963,000 gallons of water from LWC from June 2014 to May 2015. At the current rate, total cost (including service charges of \$5272.56) would be \$501,894.86. With the wholesale increase, the new cost is expected to be \$515,181.85 (including service charges of \$5,711.40). The difference between the current cost and proposed cost will be \$13,286.99. The incremental cost in terms of water sold is \$0.04667 cents per 1,000 gallons. We propose to raise each our customer's rate by \$.05 per 1,000 gallons.

On behalf of Louisville Water Company, thank you for attending the meeting of our wholesale customers and regional partners earlier this month. I appreciate the opportunity for feedback from this important customer group.

As previously discussed at the above meeting, the wholesale commodity charge effective July 1, 2015 will be \$1.80 per thousand gallons, plus an elevated service area surcharge of \$0.35 per thousand gallons, for a total wholesale rate of \$2.15 per thousand gallons..

We are planning to file the necessary documentation for this new rate with the Public Service Commission (PSC) over the next few weeks. The PSC has advised us in the past that we must inform you of the proposed rate increase in the format of the notice attached on the next page, although we have already provided you notice at our wholesale customer meeting March 3, 2015.

NOTICE

The Louisville Water Company has filed a proposed rate schedule which will increase by 2.4% the rate(s) which it currently charges to West Shelby Water District for water service.

Louisville Water Company currently charges West Shelby Water District a \$161.88 monthly meter fee, a \$277.50 monthly meter fee, \$1.80 per thousand gallons, and \$0.30 elevated service area surcharge per thousand gallons, for a total rate of \$2.10 per thousand gallons.

Louisville Water Company proposes to charge West Shelby Water District a \$175.35 monthly meter fee, a \$300.60 monthly meter fee, and \$1.80 per thousand gallons, and \$0.35 elevated service area surcharge per thousand gallons, for a total rate of \$2.15 per thousand gallons, effective July 1, 2015.

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by Louisville Water Company. The Public Service Commission, however, may order rates to be charged that differ from the proposed rates contained in this notice.

Any corporation, association or person with a substantial interest in the matter may, by written request, within thirty (30) days after publication or mailing of this notice of the proposed rate changes request to intervene. Intervention may be granted beyond the thirty (30) day period for good cause shown.





Ray Larmee, Commission Chairman, called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

Reading of Minutes:

Ben made a motion to approve the minutes from the May 2015 meeting. Ray seconded the motion.

Business:

Windhurst Development- Kevin Young with Land Design, presented a zoning change plan for a 204 unit apartment development. The plans were reviewed by Eddie and Steve. Ray signed it upon their recommendation.

Waterline Improvements Phase I – Eddie reported that Twin States is approximately 80% complete on the waterline upgrade. Pay estimates were reviewed and signed for \$54,056.46 to Twin States and \$8,698.74 to Kenvirons.

WSWD's New Office Building – Ray made a motion based on Ben's recommendation, to hire 5253 Design Group, Chris Cottingham, as the architect for West Shelby's new office. Ben seconded the motion.

Equestrian Lakes- An amended preliminary plat was presented by Lane Hartman with Magan Engineering. The plat was reviewed by Steve and Eddie and approved and signed by Ray.

Hite's Report:

Hite said that he has presented dates to the Cheatham's attorney that Steve is available for the deposition and is awaiting their response.

Steve's Report:

Steve presented a plat on, Tingle Surveys behalf, to divide tracts on Shelbyville Road near Collins High School. Plat was approved and signed by Ray.
