ORDINANCE 2015-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WARSAW, IN GALLATIN COUNTY, KENTUCKY, CREATING FRANCHISES FOR THE ERECTION, LAYING AND MAINTENANCE OF TELEPHONE AND/OR CABLE TELEVISION FACILITIES AND APPURTENANT FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT IN, ALONG AND ACROSS THE PUBLIC WAYS, ROADS, STREETS, ALLEYS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES IN THE CITY OF WARSAW, KENTUCKY: FOR FURNISHING AND SELLING TELEPHONE AND/OR CABLE TELEVISION SERVICES AND PRODUCTS BY MEANS OF SAID FACILITIES; AND PROVIDING FOR THE SALE OF SAID FRANCHISES.

WHEREAS, the City of Warsaw ("City") wishes to ensure that telephone and cable television service continues to be furnished to its citizens in a reliable and efficient manner;

WHEREAS, the City is aware that the provision of such service requires the continued use of public streets, ways, alleys and other public places;

WHEREAS, the franchises granted to and acquired by the current franchisees under which they provide such telephone and cable television service has or will expire;

WHEREAS, the City wishes to provide for the sale of new franchises for the benefit of its citizenry, giving effect to Section 96.010 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED as follows:

<u>SECTION 1:</u> Nonexclusive competitive franchises ("Franchises") to use the City's public rights-of-way, public streets, ways, alleys and other public places are hereby created.

SECTION 2: The Franchises created by this Ordinance shall be bid in accordance with the applicable requirements of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Kentucky and Chapter 424 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes, as well as any applicable City Ordinances.

<u>SECTION 3</u>: The Franchises created by this Ordinance shall be awarded to the highest and best bidders as shall be determined by the City in its sole discretion. In awarding the Franchises, the City shall consider the technical, managerial, and financial qualifications of the bidders to perform their obligations under the Franchises.

SECTION 4: The winning bidders and the City shall negotiate, execute and be bound by Franchise Agreements to contain terms that are fair and reasonable to the City, to the purchasers of the Franchises and to the patrons of the utilities, pursuant to KRS Section 96.010. Such Franchise Agreements shall take effect upon execution and according to the terms of the Agreements.

SECTION 5: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this



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Ordinance are hereby repealed.

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<u>SECTION 6</u>: Should any section, clause, line, paragraph, or part of this Ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance or the attached Agreement, as applicable.

<u>SECTION 7</u>: Time is of the essence in carrying out the terms and the provisions of this Ordinance and the Franchises created herein.

<u>SECTION 8</u>: This Ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage and publication.

SECTION 9: The foregoing Ordinance was read, passed and adopted by the Council of the City of Warsaw, Kentucky, meeting in regular session on the _____ day of ______, 2015, and in regular session on the _____ day of ______, 2015, with _____ yes votes, _____ no votes, and _____ abstentions, and was ordered published in summary according to law.
