
This is an application (original and 10 copies) to pass through an increase in sanitary sewer treatment charges for the Sewer Service Tariff of the Jessamine-South Elkhorn Water District caused by a corresponding increase of sanitary sewer treatment charges by the Lexington Fayette Urban County Government ("LFUCG"). These charges will apply to all of the District's sanitary sewer customers.

Enclosed please find: 1) proposed tariff sheets along with cost justification sheets (LFUCG notice of increase); 2) notice to customers; 3) affidavit of District's representative that the notice was mailed to all sanitary sewer customers; and 4) transmittal letter to Kentucky Attorney General evidencing electronic transmission of this filing to that office at that office at that office at [rateinventory@ag.Ky.gov](mailto:rateinventory@ag.Ky.gov).

The District has previously filed income statements and balance sheets with the Commission that are currently on file in your office.

My client is not requesting a rate increase at this time. However, increased costs attributable to the subject nonrecurring charges increase cannot be financially absorbed by the District. The additional revenue generated by the proposed nonrecurring charges will not exceed five (5%) percent of the total revenues provided by all nonrecurring charges for the recent twelve (12) month period.
