
MARION COUNTY, KENTUCKY'S MOTION TO INTERVENE

Comes Marion County, Kentucky ("Marion County"), by counsel, and pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001 Section 3(8), and moves that it be granted leave to intervene in this matter and that it be granted full intervention status. Approval of the application in this matter will have a significant impact on Marion County as it is the local government primarily responsible for the administration and maintenance of the Central Kentucky 9-1-1 Network pursuant to the agreements under which the network was created and operates and it uses the network to provide services to the citizens of Marion County. To the extent appropriate and necessary, Marion County also moves to intervene on behalf of the Central Kentucky 9-1-1 Network.

Marion County has a special interest in this matter, and it will not be adequately represented by the other parties. Marion County's participation in this matter is also likely to assist the Commission in developing and identifying facts and issues and in fully considering this matter without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings.


