NOTICE OF ENACTED TAXES BY THE LOUISVILLE URBAN SERVICES DISTRICT BOARD FOR 2015-2016

Be advised that in accordance with KRS 67C.147 and Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government Ordinance 2, Series 2003, that on September 15, 2015 the Louisville Urban Services District Board enacted the following ad valorem taxes on certain personal property and an occupational license fee on health insurance companies within the Louisville Urban Services District for Fiscal Year 2015-2016:

On tangible personal property including, but not limited to public service corporations, distilled spirits, but excluding merchants' inventories, manufacturers' finished goods; goods stored in a warehouse/distribution center, aircraft not used in the business of transporting persons or property for compensation or hire, motor vehicles and motorboats, a tax of 56.6 cents per \$100 of assessed valuation. Tax bills will be mailed by early November and require payment with a two percent (2%) discount by December 1, 2015, or without a discount by December 31, 2015.

On all financial institutions, as defined in KRS 136.500, a franchise tax at the rate of twenty-five thousandths of one percent (0.025%) on all deposits, as defined in KRS 136.575. As provided in KRS 136.575(3) a tax bill shall be sent to the financial institutions no later than December 1, 2015 and require payment with a two percent (2%) discount by December 31, 2015 or without discount by January 31, 2016.

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Report: Driver in fatal crash that killed 4 had taken opioids

Heroin or prescription painkillers may have contributed to the deaths of four people on Sept. 1, when a driver crashed head-on into a family's vehicle in Fort Wright.

Kenneth Hartsock, the 48-year-old driver who crashed into a car carrying three people on Highland Pike

near Reeves Drive, had opioids in his system at the time of the crash, according to a preliminary report from the medical examiner's office. Kenton County Police Chief Spike Jones said that it's unknown whether the opioids in Hartsock's system came from heroin or prescription painkillers.

"Whether he was abusing prescription medication or heroin, at the end of the day, the result is the tragic

death of four people," Jones told The Enquirer on Tuesday. "His driving impaired led to the death of three innocent people, and himself."

Hartsock's car hit a car being driven by a woman with her sister in the passenger seat and her husband in the back seat. Sarah Willis, 70, of Bromley, was driving west on Highland Pike when Hartsock's car, headed east, crossed lanes and struck her

vehicle just before 3 p.m. that day, police said. Her husband, John Willis, 79, was treated at the scene but died. Sarah Willis and her sister, Gloria Roaden, 72, of Ludlow, were dead when emergency responders arrived.

Jones said the case "speaks even louder" to the need to get the heroin and prescription painkiller epidemic that the region, and the nation, is struggling with, under control.

If these two ethical giants protest your protests, then feel free to remind them of this: Teaching kids it's OK to use a justifiably radioactive word is like sending them out in shackles. Saying it publicly will get them in trouble in school now, hurt their standing among well-raised peers as they mature, and be potentially lethal to them professionally when their time comes to earn their keep.

Hi, Carolyn: I often discuss difficult but pretty standard problems about shared custody after divorce with a friend whose responses seem unnecessarily harsh - that I just want

to "wallow" and "play the victim" and I'm going to "#@\$ up my kids." If I protest, I'm accused of "not wanting to hear the truth." When I object to the tone of her texts, the friend will continue with angry texts saying I don't appreciate her being there for me.

When does "tough love" cross over into abusive tirades? I'm a firm believer that you can be helpful and even critical, but in a loving, supportive way.

Discuss your divorce constantly, and even gentle friends sprout fangs - but that's another column.

Whether her "tough love" is abusive is a moot point anyway; what matters is whether she's helpful. By your account, she's only helping herself feel superior. If your ex-marriage played out this way or if it's otherwise your pattern, then please consider naming a competent therapist as your new counsel in chief.
