OCTOBER 1, 2015

Pursuant to the Commission Staff's September 14, 2015 Notice, a telephonic informal conference was held in this matter on September 14, 2015. A list of attendees is attached to this memorandum.

Staff requested clarifying information from Atmos Energy Corporation ("Atmos") regarding any change in route for the "Shelbyville line", which was referenced in the response to Item 3 of Staff's Initial Request for Information ("Staff's First Request"). Atmos discussed the fact that the magnitude of the route changes was not significant, and agreed to provide for the record of this proceeding maps and a narrative discussion to clarify that the route of the Shelbyville line is essentially unchanged.

Staff also requested further information regarding the bid amounts provided in response to Item 2.a. of Staff's First Request, and how the chosen bid amount was incorporated in the Pipeline Contractor Installation cost provided in the cost comparison which was included in the message attached as an Appendix to Staff's First Request. Atmos agreed to provide a written response for the record confirming that it had chosen the \$6.87 million low bid from Company A; how that bid was incorporated into the \$13.1 million current projection of Pipeline Contractor Installation costs; how the \$6.87 million bid compared to the original estimate referenced on the last page of its application in the statement "Unfortunately, the lowest bid was considerably higher than the original estimate;" and a breakdown of all components of the \$8.1 million initial estimate of Pipeline Contractor Installation cost compared to the \$13.1 million current projection of those costs.

Finding that there were no further questions, the informal conference was adjourned.
