AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT OF SALE AND TRANSFER

THIS AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT OF SALE AND TRANSFER is made and entered into this 21 day of October, 2015, by and between **TROUBLESOME**CREEK ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORITY, INC. ("TEA"), a Public Corporation, PARTY OF

THE FIRST PART, and KNOTT COUNTY WATER AND SEWER, INC., a Kentucky non-profit corporation, ("KCW&S"), PARTY OF THE SECOND PART,

<u>WITNESSETH:</u>

WHEREAS, the Parties are currently operating under an Agreement of Sale and Transfer dated October 1, 2014, ("the Agreement"), and

WHEREAS, implementation of Agreement has revealed an omission which the Parties now desire to remedy.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of \$1.00 cash in hand paid, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

- (1) Article 8 Payment of the original Agreement states:
- 8. Payment: KCW&S declares that it is crucial to financially support TEA, so the Highway 80 Corridor sewer line project can be completed. Starting with the date of this Agreement, KCW&S shall pay a stipend not to exceed \$7,500.00 per year to TEA. These payments are earmarked for corporate governance purposes which are necessary for TEA to maintain its good standing as a public corporate entity. Such cost includes, Secretary of State annual fees, Audit of Finances by CPA, other dues and fees, Directors Insurance and publication notices. This stipend will be paid on a draw basis. TEA will present a copy of the particular bill to KCW&S who in turn will issue funds to TEA for payment.

This stipend is deemed to be a draw against the total yearly amount, so if any portion is unused, there will be no carry forward of unused funds into the next year. The yearly stipend will continue for two years or until the Highway 80 sewer project is completed.

Article 8 is hereby amended to add:

TEA agrees to prepare a spreadsheet of recognized and expected corporate governance expenses over a two-year period to be attached to this Amendment within ten days. Once the expense spreadsheet is presented, then KCW&S is obligated to pay only those listed expenses and is relieved of the obligation to pay \$7,500 stipend. Both Parties agree that the obligation by KCW&S to pay the spreadsheet expenses shall be for two years, beginning with the date of this Amendment.

All other provisions set out in the original Agreement remain in full force and effect.
