An application has been filed with the Kentucky Public Service Commission to increase rates as follows:


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As noted above, based on the increased cost of water from Paducah Water, rates will increase \$0.20 per 1,000 gallons. The monthly bill for a customer using an average of 5,000 gallons of water each month will increase from \$33.25 to \$34.25. This is an increase of \$1.00 or 3%.

The charges/rates contained in this notice are the charges/rates proposed by the West McCracken County Water District.
