On December 18, 2015, the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") issued an order in the above-captioned proceeding suspending the proposed tariff for one day and making it effective January 1, 2016, subject to refund. Due to the nature of the Gas Line Tracker ("GLT") mechanism, actual costs are "trued up" on annual basis. Because refunding these rates may be complicated, Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E") would prefer that the Commission continue to suspend the proposed rates until approved. Actual costs will be recovered through the balancing mechanism going forward.

LG&E respectfully requests the Commission to amend its Order of December 18, 2015, and suspend the proposed rates until their review is complete.
