

1. That Applicant is a water district created and existing under and by virtue of Chapter 74 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes.

That Applicant, pursuant to the provisions of KRS 278.023, seeks (i) a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN"), permitting Applicant to construct a waterworks improvement project (the "Project"); (ii) an Order approving increased water rates; and (iii) approval of the proposed plan of financing said Project.

4. That the Project consists of the (i) installation of approximately 43,000 linear feet of water transmission main and associates appurtenances; and (ii) acquisition of approximately 2,000 radio read meters including equipment and software. Contracts 1 and 2 involving the installation of the water transmission main have been bid. The radio read meters have not been bid, however, the Applicant contemplates bidding same in the near future. The Project budget contains a dollar figure for the meters, which figure shall not be exceeded.
