Refer to the Application, Exhibit 4, Section 5.3, the geotechnical study which sets forth the recommendations by Environmental Resources Management Consulting Company, LLC ("ERMC2") for site preparation for constructing the foundation for the proposed cell tower, which is located on a reclaimed mine site. Confirm that appropriate site preparation and foundation construction will be conducted in accordance with the recommendations by ERMC2 as set forth in Section 5.3 of the geotechnical study.

Response 2: Appropriate site preparation and foundation construction will be conducted. Richard D. Smith, a Professional Engineer with ERMC2, conducted a site visit on March 29, 2016. As a result of his site visit, Mr. Smith concluded that ten feet of undercut, as originally recommended in Section 5.3 of the ERMC2 report, will not be necessary based on actual site conditions. The Engineering Report dated March 29, 2016, containing Mr. Smith's findings and bearing his seal is attached hereto as Exhibit B.

Re: Site Visit for Review of Foundation Preparation for the Hippo Tower Site, In Floyd County, Kentucky. ERMC² Job Number 165-000-0018. .

A site investigation was conducted on March 29th 2016 by a qualified representative of ERMC2 to review the foundation preparation for this tower. Our report dated January 18th 2016 recommended ten feet of undercut to remove any unwanted large rocks and unsuitable material directly beneath the foundation. During our site review the inspection of the footing area was clear of any unwanted oversize materials and was excavated and backfilled to the approximate subgrade elevation with suitable material for the footer base. Therefore the total of ten feet of undercut will not be necessary.
