Dear Ms. Leitch,

This is in response to your letter dated March 23, 2016, in which you objected to the construction of the subject cell phone tower on the basis that you believe the tower will be unsightly. The subject tower is being constructed as part of the U.S. Mobility Fund established by the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC"), which is a program designed to expand mobile broadband coverage in rural and unserved parts of the country. As part of this program, Appalachian Wireless has committed to providing coverage to a minimum of 75% of the road miles in the specified areas, including the area where the subject tower is being constructed. Construction of a tower in this area is necessary in order to satisfy our obligations to the FCC. It is our belief that providing the infrastructure necessary for broadband coverage improves the communities that we serve.
