Disinfection by-products (DBPs) are becoming the most common source of water quality related violations facing drinking water utilities now that the Stage 2 Disinfection By-Product Rule goes is in full affect. Water utilities encounter significant challenges in maintaining water quality once water has been pumped into the distribution system. One problem occurs with areas where maintaining a proper chlorine residual is difficult. Boosting chlorine is one solution, but this can significantly impact DBP formation. This session details how automatic flushing is used, its benefits to water quality, and how utilities can help control DBP formation within their distribution system.
