ORDER

Kentucky Rural Water Association ("KRWA") has applied for accreditation and approval of training sessions held at the Holiday Inn University Plaza Sloan Convention Center in Bowling Green, Kentucky, on October 25, 2016. Seven sessions were held at which water district commissioners could earn up to six credit hours of training. These training sessions provided useful information to attendees to help them better perform their duties as utility professionals and to enhance operations at their facilities.

This Commission is required to "encourage and promote the offering of high quality water district management training programs that enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties." Having reviewed KRWA's application, the Commission finds that the presentations will enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties and should be approved for a maximum of six hours of water district management training.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The presentations at the training sessions held by KRWA at the Holiday Inn University Plaza Sloan Convention Center in Bowling Green, Kentucky, on October 25, 2016, are accredited and approved for a maximum of six credit hours of water district management training.
- 2. KRWA shall retain a record of all water district commissioners attending the accredited and approved presentations.
- No later than 30 days after each presentation, KRWA shall file with the
 Commission:
- a. A sworn statement attesting that the accredited instruction was performed;
- b. A description of any changes in the presenters or the proposed curriculum that occurred after KRWA's application;
- c. The name of each attending water district commissioner, his or her water district, and the number of hours that he or she attended;
- d. A copy of any written material given to water commissioners attending the presentations; and
- e. Documents indicating whether the Kentucky Board of Certification of Water Treatment and Distribution System Operators and the Kentucky Board of Certification of Wastewater System Operators approved the training for continuing education credit.
