ORDER

On November 7, 2016, Farmdale Water District ("Farmdale") applied for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure.¹

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, finds that:

- Farmdale purchases water from Frankfort Electric & Water Plant Board ("Frankfort").
- 2. Frankfort notified Farmdale that, effective November 1, 2016, Frankfort's wholesale rate to Farmdale would increase from \$2.35 per 1,000 gallons to \$2.45 per 1,000 gallons.² Farmdale proposes to increase the water rates to its customers effective December 1, 2016, to reflect the increased cost of purchased water.
- 3. Farmdale proposes a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.16 per 1,000 gallons.
- 4. During the 12 months ended August 30, 2016, Farmdale purchased 239,368,000 gallons of water from Frankfort. During the same period, Farmdale sold

151,993,000 gallons of water. The increase in the cost of purchased water is \$23,936.80, resulting in a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.16 per 1,000 gallons.

- 5. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.16 per 1,000 gallons, as calculated in Appendix A to this Order, is fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.
- 6. Farmdale's proposed rates, as set forth in Appendix B to this Order, are fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved for water service rendered by Farmdale on and after December 1, 2016.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.16 per 1,000 gallons is approved.
- 2. Farmdale's proposed rates as set forth in Appendix B to this Order are approved for water service rendered by Farmdale on and after December 1, 2016.
- 3. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Farmdale shall file with the Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revised tariff sheets showing the rates approved herein.
