

NOTICE OF CORRECTION

On March 4, 2016, Mountain Rural Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Inc. ("Mountain") filed an Application for a General Adjustment in Rates (the "Application") with the Public Service Commission of the Commonwealth of Kentucky (the "Commission"). Upon review of the original Attachment C to Exhibit 1 to its Application ("Original Attachment C"), Mountain has determined that an inadvertent Microsoft Excel coding error created an incorrect annualized net impact amount of \$198,096.54 instead of the correct annualized net impact amount of \$296,171.61. As a result, Mountain hereby corrects these inadvertent errors as follows.

1. A new and corrected Attachment C to Exhibit 1 of the Application ("New Attachment C") is enclosed and should replace the Original Attachment C filed with the Application on March 15, 2016.¹

¹ On April 12, 2016, the Commission granted Mountain's Petition for Confidential Treatment as it pertained to its Application (including the confidential information contained in Attachment C to Exhibit 1). Mountain respectfully requests that this information be accepted and filed pursuant to the Commission's April 12, 2016, Order Regarding Request for Confidential Treatment in Case No. 2016-00047. Mountain further notes that, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Sections 13(2)(a)(3) and 13(2)(b), one (1) copy of the hardcopy pages containing confidential information, with the confidential information highlighted with transparent ink, printed on yellow paper, or otherwise marked "CONFIDENTIAL," is being filed with this Notice of Correction. A copy of those pages with the confidential information redacted is also being filed with the original and each of the ten (10) copies to be filed with this Notice of Correction.

2. In Paragraph 14 of Mountain's Application, the amount "\$198,000.00" should be replaced with "\$296,000.00" in order to be consistent with New Attachment C.

3. On Page 3 of the "Proposed Revisions and Customer Impact" section of the Exhibit to the Application, the amount "\$198K" should be replaced with "\$296K" in order to be consistent with New Attachment C.
