

NOTICE OF CLARIFICATION

On March 15, 2016, West Kentucky Rural Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Inc. ("WK&T") filed an Application for a General Adjustment in Rates (the "Application") with the Public Service Commission of the Commonwealth of Kentucky (the "Commission"). Upon review of Exhibit 1 to its Application, WK&T recognizes that there is some potential for unnecessary confusion with respect to certain language on pages 3 and 4 of that Exhibit. Consequently, and for purposes of clarification WK&T now states as follows.

1. Exhibit 1 to the Application contains the narrative support for WK&T's proposed rate adjustment (the "Exhibit"). Page 4 of the Exhibit contains a table titled "Kentucky Study Area." The "Kentucky Study Area" refers to the "WK&T Consolidated Study Area (SAC: 260421)" reflecting that WK&T's federal reporting is done on a combined basis for its Tennessee and Kentucky operations. Consequently, WK&T, "Kentucky Study Area" encompasses WK&T's 9,553 residential and 829 business lines in Kentucky, as well as an additional 2,606 residential and 242 business lines in Tennessee, as further described in the "Company Information" section at page 3 of the Exhibit.
