**ATTORNEY GENERAL'S MOTION FOR A RULING AND ABEYANCE OF
PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

Comes now the Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, by and through his Office of Rate Intervention, and hereby moves the Commission to rule on the Attorney General's outstanding motions and to hold the procedural schedule in abeyance until the Commission does so. Should the Commission choose to deny the Attorney General's motion for an abeyance of the procedural schedule, the Attorney General moves the Commission for the opportunity to reserve his right to request a formal hearing, awaiting the Commission's order on other pending motions.

On April 28, 2016, the Attorney General filed a Motion to Compel in reply to WKG Storage, Inc.'s ("WKG") Response to Attorney General's Second Data Request. In his motion, the Attorney General requested the Commission compel WKG to fully respond to the entire data request, and in the alternative dismiss the proceeding entirely. On May 4 2016, WKG filed its response to the Attorney General's Motion to Compel, opposing the Attorney General's motion. The Commission has yet to rule on the motion(s) presented by the Attorney General. As the Attorney General still has unanswered requests which are essential to fully participate in this proceeding going forward, it is first necessary to have his motion ruled upon before requesting a formal hearing in this matter.

Additionally, the Attorney General understands the date to request a formal hearing in this case is today, and is therefore also requesting the Commission allow him to reserve his motion for a formal hearing until such time that the Commission comes to a conclusion on all outstanding motions.
