MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Comes now East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. ("EKPC"), by and through counsel, and for its motion requesting a brief extension of time to comply with a provision of the Commission's Order entered in this matter on December 1, 2015 (the "Order"), respectfully states as follows:

- 1. By way of the Order, the Commission approved EKPC's requests to acquire the Bluegrass Station and to assume the evidences of indebtedness associated with the Bluegrass Station acquisition.
- 2. EKPC consummated the acquisition of the Bluegrass Station on December 29, 2015. In accordance with ordering paragraph 2 of the Order, EKPC provided written notification of the closing to the Commission on January 5, 2016.
- 3. Pursuant to ordering paragraph 5 of the Order, EKPC must file, within thirty (30) days of the closing of the Bluegrass Station transaction, the journal entries reflecting how the transaction was recorded.

4. EKPC has worked diligently to finalize its bookkeeping and financial records for the 2015 fiscal year, but its efforts have not yet been concluded. The journal entries related to EKPC's acquisition of the Bluegrass Station are a part of this year-end process, and a brief extension of time to submit the journal entries is requested to ensure EKPC provides the Commission with accurate and appropriate information related to the acquisition's accounting.

WHEREFORE, in light of the foregoing, EKPC requests that the deadline by which it must file the subject journal entries be extended for a period of fifteen (15) days, *to wit*, until February 12, 2016.
