Please let this letter serve as our request for a deviation or waiver from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, 7 (1), related to the number of copies required for an application for a Certification of Public Convenience & Necessity - Construction. Our application will be filed with the Commission on February 5, 2016. We plan to submit an original plus 3 copies with that application.
