The above mentioned project has unfortunately been through several delays with multiple issues. The District was under the impression from the property owner that the new proposed tank site was not going to be a problem. The cost of the proposed tank site was verbally agreed upon. This was in August of 2014.

The District obtained a surveyor and the proposed tank site was surveyed off. This is when a local attorney, who is a cousin to the property owner, got involved and things got sideways. After almost eight months of negotiations the District finally obtained the property.

The proposed site was also in a heavily wooded area. This required a memorandum of agreement with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife. An agreement was entered into with U.S. Fish and Wildlife, but the property could not be cleared until after August 1, 2015 due to the summer roosting season of the Indiana Bat.

At this time the project is moving forward. All scoping letters have been sent and replies have been received. The thirty day public comments period meeting has been held. The proposed tank site will be cleared next week.

The deadline for having contracts awarded on the proposed project is October 1, 2015. The District will not be able to meet this deadline.

The District requests that you please consider granting an extension on this project. The District appreciates all the efforts of the staff at KIA and DOW on these types of projects. Thank you for your consideration on this.
