RE: Informal Conference of March 4, 2016

Pursuant to Commission Staff's March 1, 2016 notice, an informal telephonic conference ("IC") was held in this matter on March 4, 2016, at the Commission's office in Frankfort, Kentucky. A list of attendees is attached hereto.

The purpose of the IC was to discuss several issues in the above case, including the status of certain filing deficiencies in Henry County Water District No. 2's ("Henry County No. 2") application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct a water improvement project. By letter dated February 24, 2016, Commission Staff ("Staff") notified Henry County No. 2 that its application was rejected for filing, listed the deficiencies, and instructed Henry County No. 2 to provide additional information within ten days. On February 26, 2016, and March 3, 2016, respectively, Henry County No. 2 submitted a response to the filing deficiency letter, with accompanying supplemental materials. Staff confirmed that the provision of supplemental documentation satisfies the filing requirements and Henry County No. 2's application will accordingly be entered into the record as filed.

Also discussed was Staff's concern that Henry County No. 2's bids for the project were obtained prior to completed Division of Water ("DOW") approval. Henry County No. 2 informed staff that the public comment period ends March 5, 2016, and Henry County No. 2 expects DOW approval of the project to be completed the following week. Henry County No. 2 also confirmed that the bids were entered into at its own risk, and it has remained in continued contact with the Kentucky Infrastructure Authority ("KIA") to keep the KIA apprised of the bid status. Henry County No. 2 also pointed to the fact that it has entered no contract to date, and the bid it received specifies that it can reject the bid for any reason.

Finding that no party had any further questions the conference was adjourned.
