## MOTION OF U.S. 60 WATER DISTRICT OF SHELBY AND FRANKLIN COUNTIES, KENTUCKY FOR 45-DAY EXTENSION OF TIME

Comes U.S. 60 Water District of Shelby and Franklin Counties, Kentucky ("U.S. 60"), by counsel, and moves the Public Service Commission ("PSC") for a 45-day extension of time during which to comply with the internal inspection requirement set forth in Paragraph 2 of the Stipulation of Facts and Settlement Agreement which was incorporated into the PSC's Order entered herein on August 17, 2015. In support of this Motion, U.S. 60 states that it has engaged the services of Jay L. Hoffman of Wet or Dry Tank Inspection, 1609 Hillsboro Road, Campbellsburg, Kentucky to conduct an internal inspection of U.S. 60's remaining two older inservice water tanks, namely the Clay Village standpipe and the Driscoll elevated tank. U.S. 60 is next on Mr. Hoffman's list of inspections to perform. He has advised U.S. 60 he has been unable to conduct the inspections due to the adverse weather conditions. It is expected the inspections will be performed within the next two weeks or so; however, U.S. 60 deems it prudent to ask for an additional 45 days to allow the inspections to be completed.

U.S. 60's two other tanks are not scheduled for inspection. The 750,000 Peytona elevated storage tank is brand new, having been placed into operation last year after the PSC Order was entered. The old Peytona welded steel standpipe tank has been removed from service, drained except for approximately 30 feet of remaining water to provide structural stability, and is

awaiting demolition and removal as soon as an acceptable contractor can be located.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, U.S. 60 respectfully requests a 45-day extension of time through and including April 4, 2016 in which to complete the internal inspection of U.S. 60's remaining two older in-service storage tanks.
