

To whom it may concern:

This letter is in response to a request for more information on case number 2016-00114. In regards to section 1 of the request the Dexter-Almo Water District has no plans to construct any water storage tanks within the next 5 years. The district does not have the financial means to take on a project of this magnitude or the maintenance of a water storage tank at this time without the help from outside funding sources. The district has not started to plan for any kind of project like this since the relationship and available storage from our supplier has been sufficient in the past the district has seen no need in pursuing a project like this. The district has ample inventory of repair supplies and contractors available 24/7/365 to repair any immediate outage of service and average time for the water service to be shut down during an outage is approx. 2 hours. If outage can't be repaired in timely matter the district has the resources either in house or with help from neighboring utilities to get service interruption fixed as soon as possible, even if it meant working around the clock to restore water service.

At present time the City of Murray is ensuring the district that they have the means to meet water storage requirements for them and for the district. The city stated in a letter first submitted with this application that this is no hindrance to their system and capable of meeting the demands of the water district as well and that their capabilities and agreements with the district will be reviewed every 3 years to ensure that all requirements can be meet for them and for the district. If at some point the current infrastructure between the City of Murray and the district is no longer viable to meet requirements the city and the district will work together and do whatever means necessary to ensure requirements will be meet in a timely manner.
