Water Rate Agreement

This Agreement made and entered into this 1st day of April, 2016, by and between the City of Lancaster, referred to herein as the "City", and the Garrard County Water Association, referred to herein as the "Association".

Witnesseth: That whereas by a contract dated March 25, 1970, an arrangement was made that the rate to be charged for water supplied by the City to the Association would be subject to modification every five years based on a demonstrable increase in the cost of performance, such cost not to include increased capitalization of the Lancaster system.

That whereas this time period was shortened to one year by subsequent agreements and that the latest one year agreement expires at the close of the day on June 30, 2014 and whereas this latest one year agreement introduced the concept of a guaranteed minimum purchase by the Association from the City.

Now, therefore, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- That the original five year pricing period will continue to be shortened to one year.
- 2. That the rate charged by the City for water supplied to the Association will increase to \$2.05 per thousand gallons for the next year. There will be a Kentucky River Fee of \$.16 added. If there is an increase in the Kentucky River Fee it will be passed on to the purchaser in the next billing cycle after becoming effective. The increased rate is to take effect on May 3, 2016. This agreement will remain in effect to May 31, 2017.
- 3. The Association agrees to a minimum purchase amount of 200 million gallons per year or until such time as the City of Lancaster requests an additional rate increase and/or the City of Lancaster no longer controls, owns, or operates the treatment facility, the Garrard Co. Water Association has the first right of refusal on the sale of such said facility.
- 4. That the costs and methodology used to arrive at the price increase noted above will be reviewed in 2016 by an independent third party to identify any need for an increase or decrease in wholesale rates if needed.
- All other provisions of the original contract between the parties will remain in full force and effect.
