The North Shelby Water Company respectfully requests that the Commission allow for an adjustment to our rates in accordance with 807 KAR 5:068 Purchased Water Adjustment clause.

The Company was recently notified by its supplier, Louisville Water Company, that it will increase meter service charges by \$45.60 per month and wholesale rates by \$0.05 per 1000 gallons. These increases will take effect July 1, 2016. The result of these increases is \$17,361.00 in additional yearly supply cost for the Company. This translates into \$0.05 per 1000 gallons of water sold to our customers. Therefore, we propose to increase our rates by that amount.

Please find attached information regarding the proposed increase in wholesale rates for water sold by Louisville Water Company (LWC) to the North Shelby Water Company (North Shelby). In addition to discussions with individual wholesale customers, LWC had a general meeting with all the wholesale customers March 8, 2016. We continue to follow the same wholesale rate increase process as in previous years. As a result, please find attached the following information and copies of the following documents:

Exhibit 1 - The current rates for wholesale sales of water by LWC to North Shelby are governed by the original Water Purchase Agreement dated July 9, 1984 (Paragraph 4), and the Water Purchase Agreement dated February 19, 1992 (Paragraph 4). There is also a First Amendment to Water Purchase Agreement dated December 15, 2000, providing for an additional meter and term extension, and a Second Amendment to Water Purchase Agreement dated April 25, 2013, providing for increased flow. Copies of these contracts are enclosed as Exhibit 1.

Exhibit 2 - Pursuant to the Commission's Order in Adm. Case No. 351, LWC filed its original tariff governing the sale of water on a wholesale basis to North Shelby on September 23, 1994. The first rate increase since that time was filed on March 12, 2004. Attached are the following:
